This hair exhibits the same individual microscopic characteristics as the pubic hairs of JEFFREY MACDONALD, and accordingly, is consistent with having originated from JEFFREY MACDONALD.

It is pointed out that hair comparisons do not constitute a basis for absolute personal identification.

One brown hair of Caucasian origin was found in specimen Q87 (CID #E-52NB) (debris from bedspread in Kristen MacDonald's bedroom). This hair does not possess sufficient characteristics to be of value for significant comparison purposes.
